



Ken Loeppky CPM, Elected as President of BOMA Canada

Ottawa, ON – **Ken Loeppky** CPM, Vice President Research Park Operations of Saskatchewan has been named the 2007 President of the Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) of Canada, representing the Canadian commercial real estate industry.

Currently serving as Vice President, Research Park Operations, Mr. Loeppky is responsible for two 78 acre science and technology parks in Saskatoon and Regina, as well as a forestry research centre in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan – a portfolio that exceeds 1.3 million square feet housing 170 tenants and over 3,000 occupants.

Mr. Loeppky’s twenty-five year career in the real estate industry has included positions in both the public and private sectors. Currently the President of BOMA Canada, he has been actively involved with BOMA Regina for ten years, serving on the Board since 1999, including as President. With BOMA Regina, he has chaired the Property Tax Review Committee, Golf Tournament Committee and Programs Committee, and has been active on the Bylaw Review and Education Day Committees. At the national level, Mr. Loeppky served on the BOMA Canada Board of Directors from 2001 to 2003, and in 2004 he was elected Secretary Treasurer of the organization. He has also been a member of the Executive Committee of BOMA International since June 2005.
